

FACULTY OF MEDICINE AND HEALTH SCIENCES HARRY CROSSLEY FOUNDATION RESEARCH PROJECT FUNDING

Purpose

Harry Crossley Foundation (HCF) funding is earmarked to support **research project running costs** for one year. This opportunity is only available to **Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences (FMHS) postdoctoral fellows and post-graduate students** and should **not** be confused with the [Harry Crossley Scholarship](#) (bursary) that is available to all Stellenbosch University (SU) Masters and Doctoral students and for which applications are made online through the SU Postgraduate Office.

Eligibility

- (1) Masters and Doctoral students (full time or part-time), registered at the FMHS
- (2) Staff who are also enrolled as postgraduate students at the FMHS
- (3) Postdoctoral fellows at the FMHS

Only one application per person may be submitted.

NOTE: Honours research projects will in future be supported by the Undergraduate Research Fund. More information about Honours applications is available on the [Undergraduate Research Project Fund webpage](#).

Award

Funding awards will be disbursed **proportionally**, in the **following categories**, with maximum amounts as follows:

Masters student projects: Will account for 40% of awards, **up to R 40 000 per application**.

Doctoral student projects: Will account for 40% of awards, **up to R 80 000 per application**.

Postdoctoral fellow projects: Will account for 20% of awards, **up to R 100 000 per application**.

Applications, for which the funding request exceeds the maximum Harry Crossley Foundation funding award in a given category, will not be considered. The budget should mainly be for **research project running costs (consumables)**.
