December 2025:


Call for rating applications open

05 February 2026:	First internal closing date for all applications. *All applications must be submitted on NRFConnect to be eligible for internal review.
06 February 2026:	Applications are sent to internal panel members for evaluation and feedback
06 February - 19 February 2026:	Panel members work through applications and prepare feedback
19 February 2026:	Panel members send written feedback to the Division for Research Development or to the applicant directly. Division for Research Development open applications on NRFConnect for revision.
4 March 2026:	Second internal closing date for all applications. *All applications must be submitted on NRFConnect to be eligible for internal review.
16 March – 20 March 2026:	Committee meetings take place
31 March 2026:	Expected final closing date for all applications on the NRF system.

An update will be provided as soon as the NRF officially opens the call.

We have received a communiqué from the NRF (see **below** or attached) indicating that they are aiming to open the rating applications before the end of December.




Dear Designated Authorities




