

How to pay your application fee 2027 intake

1. APPLICATION FEE

1.1 An application fee of R100 is payable by all undergraduate and postgraduate South African citizens

1.2 An application fee of R100 is also payable by the following categories of applicants:

- Holders of permanent residence in South Africa.
- Holders of refugee status in South Africa.
- Holders of asylum seeker status in South Africa.
- Holders of diplomatic status in South Africa.

Please note that the system will request a R400 application fee. You can either pay ONLY the R100 application fee via EFT or receive a refund of R300 if you pay the R400 fee online.

1.3 The application fee for undergraduate and postgraduate international applicants is R400. Click [HERE](#) for more information in this regard.

1.4 For Stellenbosch Business School (SBS) applicants, the application fee is R1050 for an MBA and R850 for all other SBS programmes. You can visit the Business School [website](#) for more information.

2. EXEMPTION OF AN APPLICATION FEE

2.1 Depending on the quantile of your school, applicants for undergraduate programmes might be exempt from any application fee.

2.2 If this applies to your application, you will see “Application Fee - R0.00” on the Payment and agreement page.

2.3 South African applicants experiencing financial challenges and cannot pay the application fee, can send a motivation to our Client Service Centre at info@sun.ac.za.

2.4 **Please note:** This option is only available to South Africans applying to Stellenbosch and/or Tygerberg campus.

2.5 Current SU students are exempt from paying the application fee.



3. PAYMENT OPTIONS

If an application fee payment is required, you have the following payment options:

3.1 Online payment

- Online payment is the easiest and fastest way to pay your application fee.
- If you select “online payment”, you will be directed to the online payment portal.
- Proceed to the “Payment options” section.
- By selecting the card option, you will be directed to the electronic payment screen.

3.2 EFT Payment

- The guideline for an EFT payment is as follows:

Stellenbosch University is registered as an approved beneficiary on all major banking websites. It is therefore unnecessary to insert our bank account details when registering us as a beneficiary.

Simply select ‘Stellenbosch University Student Fees’ from the approved beneficiary list and use your unique application ID as reference to add us as a beneficiary.

- You can upload your proof of payment on the applicant portal while completing the EFT information.
