The aim of this programme is to provide educators for high school teaching.

Requirements:

- Students follow this programme after completing an appropriate Bachelor's degree such as BA, BSc or BComm, or after completing an appropriate Honours degree.
- To qualify to complete the PGCE qualification your undergraduate degree must contain two subjects to either a second or third year level (inline with the yearbook requirements) that are directly related to high school subjects.
- Please carefully read yearbook requirements for each subject specialisation.

Teaching Practice

Students partake in:

- Practical teaching during the third school term at particular secondary schools within a 50km radius of Stellenbosch University.
