

## **Coetzenburg Centre offers one-stop assisted registration hub**

The Coetzenburg Centre has been selected as the registration venue for assisted registration on the Stellenbosch campus in 2026 due to construction expanding to the northern section of the Administration A building.

Students are encouraged to register online, but for those who cannot, all registration-related services to take students through the entire process will be available at the Coetzenburg Centre from 12 January to 20 February 2026. - **Venue location and layout**

The Coetzenburg Centre (no 308 on the [\*\*campus map\*\*](#)) is located at the Coetzenburg sports complex, just off Noordwal East. Graduation ceremonies are held annually in the centre, but 2026 will be the first year that the venue will offer a one-stop hub for registration.

Work areas will be demarcated for the various student services related to registration with allocated student seating on the outer perimeter of the venue. Click [\*\*here\*\*](#) to view the floorplan of the Coetzenburg Centre.

- **Transport**

The Coetzenburg Centre is walking distance from the central campus and most residences, but a shuttle service for staff and students runs from the parking bays at the Conservatoire of Music (Konservatorium – no 72 on the [\*\*campus map\*\*](#)) in Neethling Street and the Coetzenburg Centre. For the assisted registration period the service will include a modified vehicle fitted with assistive devices.

- **Entertainment and refreshments**

Maties FM and Pokkel will entertain students and facilitate engagement on the terrain adjacent to the Coetzenburg Centre, and vendors will sell light meals, snacks and drinks. The Maties pop-up shop will also be on site. The objective is to offer students an enjoyable registration experience, especially during peak registration times.
