

Coetzenburg Centre offers one-stop assisted registration hub

The Coetzenburg Centre has been selected as the registration venue for assisted registration on the Stellenbosch campus in 2026 due to construction expanding to the northern section of the Administration A building.

Students are encouraged to register online, but for those who cannot, all registration-related services to take students through the entire process will be available at the Coetzenburg Centre from 12 January to 20 February 2026. Please refer to the <u>registration schedule</u> for the assisted registration as specific dates and timeslots are allocated to the respective faculties and programmes.

Venue location and layout

The Coetzenburg Centre (no 308 on the <u>campus map</u>) is located at the Coetzenburg sports complex, just off Noordwal East. Graduation ceremonies are held annually in the centre, but 2026 will be the first year that the venue will offer a one-stop hub for registration.

Work areas will be demarcated for the various student services related to registration with allocated student seating on the outer perimeter of the venue. Click **here** to view the floorplan of the Coetzenburg Centre.

Transport

The Coetzenburg Centre is walking distance from the central campus and most residences, but a shuttle service for staff and students runs from the parking bays at the Conservatoire of Music (Konservatorium – no 72 on the <u>campus map</u>) in Neethling Street and the Coetzenburg Centre. For the assisted registration period the service will include a modified vehicle fitted with assistive devices.

Entertainment and refreshments

Maties FM and Pokkel will entertain students and facilitate engagement on the terrain adjacent to the Coetzenburg Centre, and vendors will sell light meals, snacks and drinks. The Maties pop-up shop will also be on site. The objective is to offer students an enjoyable registration experience, especially during peak registration times.
