The Intensive English Programme (IEP) offers English language training programmes to international (undergraduate and postgraduate) students through the Language Centre of the University of Stellenbosch. The IEP develops student reading, writing, listening and speaking skills as well as relevant grammar and vocabulary in blocks of eight weeks.

IEP programmes are offered throughout the year, with outings and workshops designed to help you explore the local area and culture, practise English outside the classroom, and enjoy a collaborative learning environment. The IEP credit-bearing programmes add academic credits to your academic transcript, making them ideal for students.

What are the dates and deposit payment options?

What are the programme costs?

After your application is processed, you will receive an **invoice** with a non-refundable deposit covering the registration and programme fees, depending on your level and study period.

International Registration Fee

A non-refundable fee of R6 030 includes:

- your digital record: R350
- orientation and campus tour
- once-off one-way airport pick-up on arrival
- assistance with accommodation options
