

American High School Diploma Applicants

In order to receive a final offer from the University, if you completed an American High School Diploma, you would need to meet Exemption requirements.

You will require a Certificate of Matriculation Exemption, as issued by *USAf* (Universities SA) should you be accepted and chose to register at SU.

To view the Exemption requirements, please visit the USAf website at https://mb.usaf.ac.za/united-states-of-america/

You will need your High School Diploma and Transcript with a GPA of 3.5; plus ONE of the following exemption documents:

- SATs with the following results:
 Evidence-based reading and writing: 610; Mathematics: 530;
- AP results sheet:
 Results from 2 AP (Advanced Placement) subjects must be between 3 and 5;
- ACTs with the following results: An ACT mean of 22 with a sub-minimum of 22 in English and 21 in Mathematics;
- National Benchmark Test with the following scores
 - For a STEM area degree programme: "<u>proficient scores</u>" in Academic Literacy (AL), Quantitative Literacy (QL), and Mathematics (MAT),
 - For programmes that do not require Maths at a 4 or better in the NSC: "proficient scores" for AL & QL.

Once you have your Diploma, and ONE of the above exemption documents, you need to:

- 1. Have these documents and your ID document certified by a notary public or a South African Embassy,
- 2. And upload all these documents <u>HERE</u> from 1 November.
