

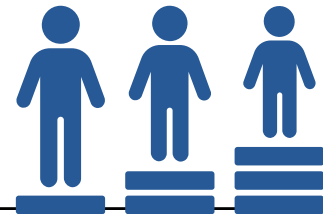

Little you is so proud right now, don't let her down.

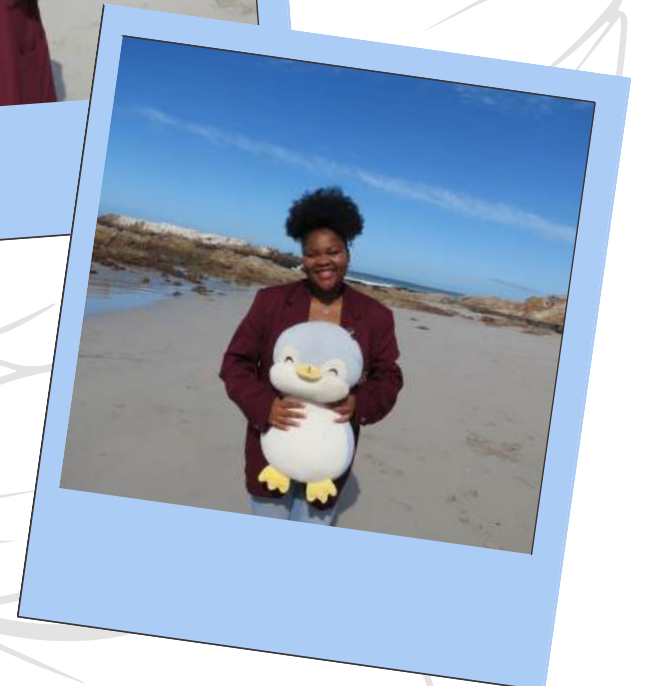

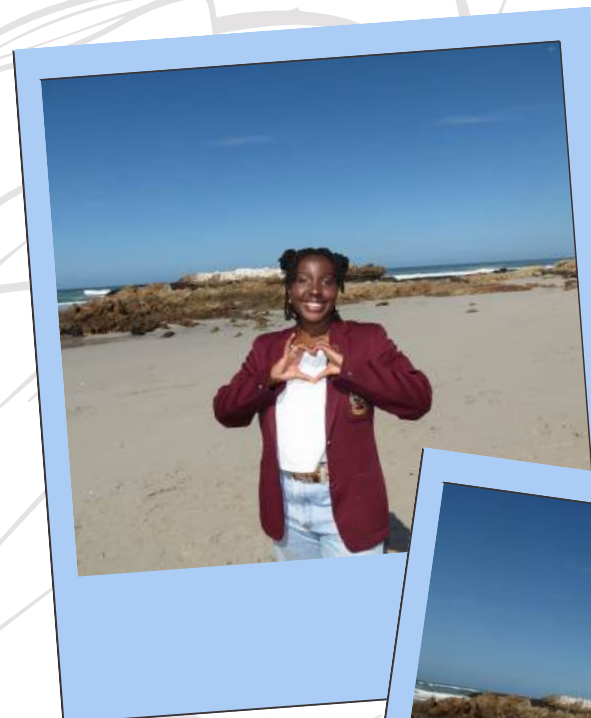

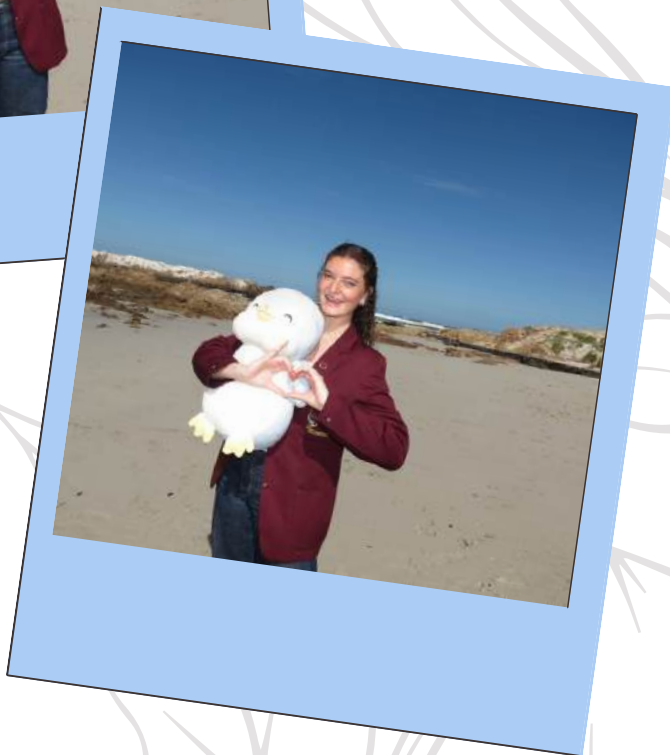

Nemesia Week

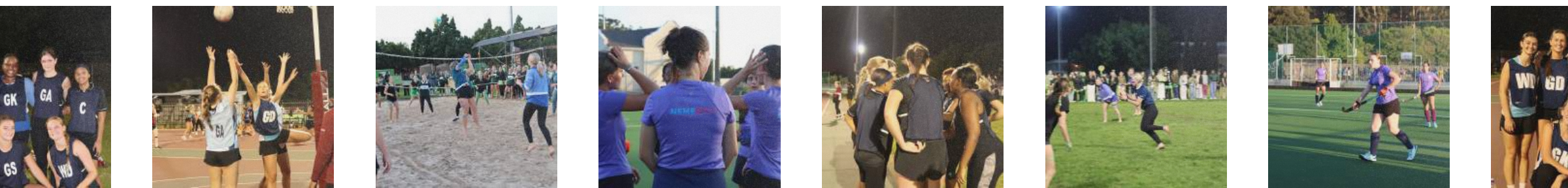



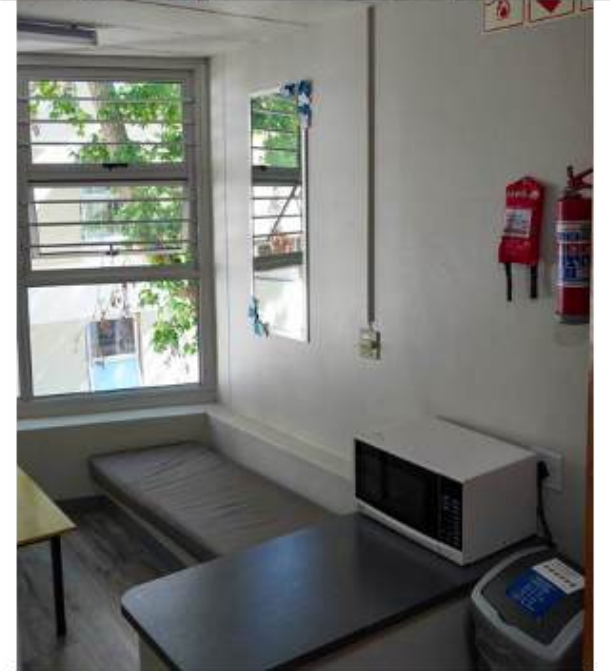

Safety Information

Dear Parents/Guardians and Newcomers of 2026,

As the Vice-Primaria, I have Safety as one of my Portfolios and this is one of the most essential responsibilities within the Residence. Ensuring the safety and well-being of every student is a priority that requires careful planning and collective cooperation. With your support and adherence to the guidelines provided, we can create an environment where all our newcomers feel secure, protected, and well cared for throughout their transition into university life.

I kindly request that you take a moment to read the following information carefully before making any appliance purchases or finalising your preparations for move-in and Welcoming.

APPLIACNES NOT ALLOWED

- Open flame or bar heaters
- Kettles in students' rooms (we have boilers with hot water available 24/7)
- Bar type cooking stoves
- Any appliance that produces an exposed heating element such as hot plates, coil stoves, gas burner.
- Microwaves (there is microwave available per floor).

ALTERNATIVES

- Fan heaters
- Desk fans
- Air fryers (which can only be used in our Kitchenets)
- Induction cooker/plate

First aid

Basic first aid support is available within the residence. The residence maintains a fully stocked first aid kit, which is managed and administered by Mpho Mokoena(Vice-Primaria). In the event that a student experiences a minor injury or requires immediate first aid assistance, appropriate care will be provided promptly and professionally. All interventions will remain within the scope of basic first aid. Should a situation arise where a student requires medical attention beyond first aid, including potential fractures, severe allergic reactions, or any condition needing professional evaluation: the student will be referred or transported to the nearest hospital or to the University Health Services, depending on the nature and urgency of the situation. Parents or guardians will be informed as appropriate.

Medication

For the safety and well-being of our students, Nemesia Residence will not be providing any form of medication to the Newcomers during the course of the welcoming period. This includes, but is not limited to, over-the-counter painkillers, allergy remedies, cold and flu medication, or any other pharmaceutical products.

The reason for this is to ensure the highest level of care, as students may have undisclosed medical conditions, allergies, or sensitivities that could be negatively affected by certain medications. To avoid any potential health risks, we strongly encourage parents to ensure that the newcomers arrive with all necessary personal medication they may require. There is Campus Health available where we will take the students if the need arises.

Move in Logistics

The law students can move in on the 26 January 2026 from 14:00-16:00. The law students are going to have their Law academic programme on the same day from 18:00-20:00 @ the Law Faculty (Old Main Building).

The rest of the newcomers are welcomed to move in on 27 January 2026 between 08:00 and 12:00. Each newcomer will be allocated one of the two moving slots — either 08:00–10:00 or 10:00–12:00. A detailed schedule confirming your specific slot will be shared closer to the day. You'll be staying in a shared double room equipped with two single beds and mattresses, two desks and chairs, two shelving units, and a closet with three doors for each person. There are two power outlets and a set of curtains. For shared facilities, there's a communal space on each floor (called Nessies) with a microwave and a boiler that provides hot water. A laundry room is also available, featuring washing machines and dryers; you'll just need to bring your own detergent. Access to these facilities is managed with your student card, and we'll go over everything in detail during Welcoming Week. You can also bring your own fridge, or communicate with your roommate before purchasing one.

There is a parent and newcomer lunch which commences on Tuesday, the 27th of January (the same day as move in day). This is an opportunity for parents to meet the Nemesia Leadership teams and be introduced to Sindi, our House Mother. We please ask that all newcomers are present for this lunch. After the lunch, Newcomers can spend time with their parents from 13:30 to 17:00. After this, the Nemesia Welcoming Week Programme officially starts, and this is where we kindly ask that your parents leave you.

Welcoming Week is a jam-packed week full of various academic, social and cultural activities with the aim of easing you into Stellenbosch life. During this time, you will be introduced to seniors and other newcomers on campus.

Welcoming is a wonderful experience, filled with many memorable moments. We hope you enjoy the experience and make new memories of your own!

Three Sisters Bursary

The Three Sisters' Bursary Fund was created to support students from Erica, Nemesia, and Serruria residences, ensuring they can pursue their studies free from the weight of financial hardship. With the ongoing challenges faced by the National Student Financial Aid Scheme and the country's difficult economic climate, many students are left battling food insecurity, period poverty, and a lack of basic study essentials.

As a community, we have chosen to take proactive steps to address these challenges. This Fund is a beacon of hope, offering deserving and talented students the opportunity to thrive academically and contribute meaningfully to the future of our nation.

While not all Nemesia Alumni can be physically present to engage with the community, they can still make a meaningful impact by contributing financially. Your support can alleviate the financial barriers that hinder students from realising their full potential.

How the Bursary works

Under the Three Sisters Bursary Fund, financial support is provided to undergraduate students residing in Nemesia, Serruria, and Erica at Stellenbosch University who demonstrate both financial need and academic merit. This includes students from the "missing middle" category, with a gross household income ranging between R350,000 and R600,000.

A maximum of R150,000 may be allocated to an individual student in a given year, depending on their specific financial requirements. To qualify for funding, students must meet all the minimum eligibility criteria outlined by the Fund.
