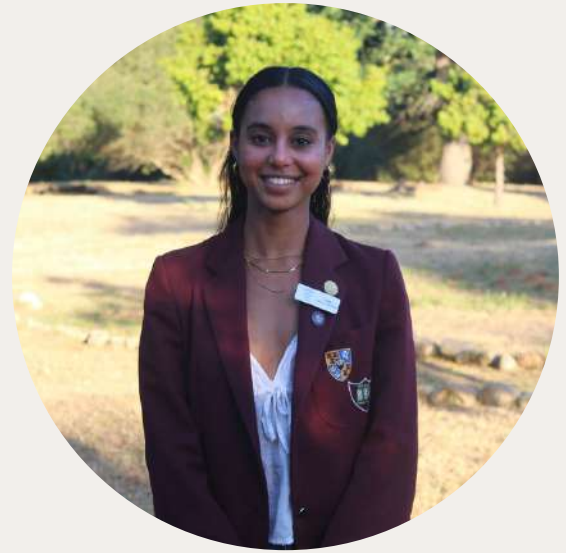

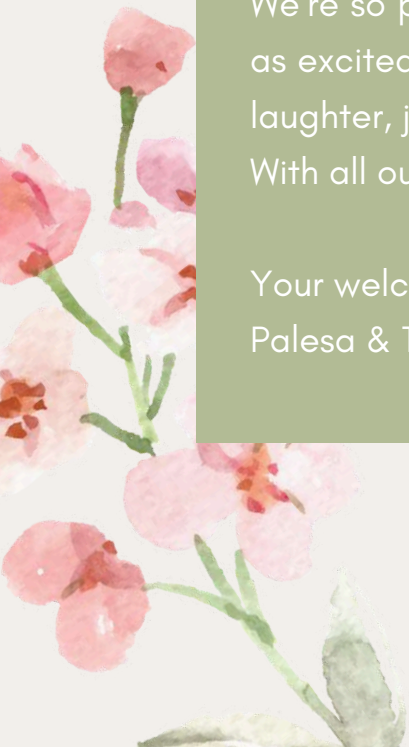

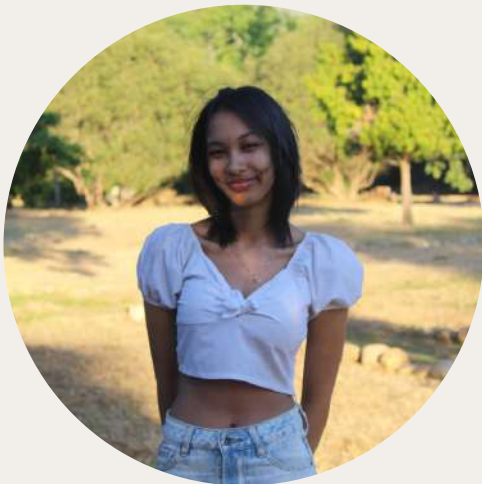

WHAT YOU'LL FIND WITHIN OUR GREEN WALLS:

- Serruria consists of 5 blocks, with 3 levels in each block:
- On each floor, there is a “**nessie**”, which is a kitchenette composed of the following:
 - Double sink
 - Drying rack
 - 3x shelves
 - 3x cupboards
 - Couch seating area
 - Hydroboil
 - Microwave
 - Stove top
- There is a bathroom on each floor:
 - Showers
 - Basins
 - Toilets
 - Washing basins
 - Washing rails

SERRURIA PANTRY

The Serruria Pantry is an initiative started by a Serrurian whose dream was to care for the needs of Serrurians within our house. It provides basic goods and necessities for those in need, alleviating food and essential item shortages within our community.

The goal is to foster unity and a sense of belonging for everyone who calls Serruria home. We encourage and appreciate donations from all newcomers upon arrival and throughout your journey at our beautiful residence.

LEARN THE LINGO

SLAKKIE:

Serruria's mascot is a slakkie (snail), named Larry! Residents from Serruria.

NESSIE:

A "Nessie" refers to the small living- and kitchen area found on each floor of every block in the residence. The Nessie consists of a microwave, a hot water boiler, washing basin, cupboards and comfortable seating area for those well deserved coffee breaks!

BLOCKS:

Serruria has five blocks (A-E) with three floors each. Each block is named after the top academic universities around the world which serves as inspiration for excellence in education within our res. There are block meetings within the year which are compulsory.

BLOCK LEADERS:

Each section will elect a leader to represent their interests in a more direct manner. Block leaders are also responsible for fire drills and safety.

THE GAT:

The "Gat", meaning hole, is a term used to refer to the rooms in the residence that start on the ground floor. These are C-gat and D-gat.

FRASS:

"Frass" is a term we use in res to refer to the "fake grass" quad. The Frass is normally used for small, intimate Serruria functions/gatherings, and/or to relax and workout.

VOORGRAS:

This is our res' 'front lawn', which is where we sometimes hold res activities or will gather to walk to a function together as a group. The voorgras is next to the parking lot, outside the front door.

CSC:

Refers to the Private Student Organisations at the University who host students that do not live in university accommodation. A CSC allows non-residents to network with other newcomers and communities.

"THREE SISTERS":

Serruria forms part of the three sister residences, the other two being Erica and Nemesia. These res' are identical in physical structure and reside next to one another.

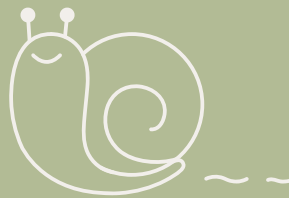
